**MEMORANDUM OF ORAL DECISION DELIVERED BY T. PREVEDEL ON
 FEBRUARY 26, 2021 AND ORDER OF THE TRIBUNAL**

[1] This was the seventh Case Management Conference (“CMC”), conducted by telephone conference call, with respect to appeals by CRH Canada Group Inc. under s. 22(7) and s. 34(11) of the *Planning Act* regarding the failure of the Township of Tiny to make a decision on applications for amendments to the Township’s Official Plan (“OP”) and Zoning By-law (“ZBL”).

[2] The purpose of these applications is to permit the expansion of an existing gravel pit for the subject property located at 2 Darby Road.

[3] An associated application has been made for a License under the *Aggregate Resources Act* (“ARA”). This Application was submitted to the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry in late February 2020 before the COVID 19 Emergency Order had been declared. The parties had anticipated that there would be a referral of the ARA Licence Application to the Tribunal by this CMC date. The intent is to have the appeals on the proposed amendments to the OP and ZBL heard at the same time as the referral under the ARA.

[4] At this CMC, Mr. Kahn advised that the long-awaited ARA referral was submitted to the Tribunal on February 25, 2021.

[5] Now that the ARA referral has been formally submitted, CRH Canada Group Inc., will be able to understand any additional concerns or objections arising from the referral.

[6] On consent, it was agreed that two additional CMC's would be required: one to identify any additional Parties or Participants arising from the ARA referral and the next one to finalize the Procedural Order and Issues List for the Hearing.

[7] A further Notice of the upcoming CMC will be required due to the ARA referral.

[8] Mr. Kahn has volunteered to prepare a draft Procedural Order and Issues List for the Parties to review in advance of the next CMC, recognizing that the Issues List may require some refinement depending on what other concerns are raised.
