MEMORANDUM OF ORAL DECISION DELIVERED BY JASON CHEE-HING ON MARCH 4, 2015 AND ORDER OF THE BOARD

- [1] This is the first pre-hearing conference ("PHC") into these matters. These matters relate to separate appeals filed by Garth Trails Limited ("GTL") and Gabriel Gasbarrini against the decision of the City of Hamilton ("City") Council to approve Official Plan Amendment No. 24 ("OPA 24"), to the Urban Hamilton Official Plan. OPA 24 is also known as the Ancaster Wilson Street Secondary Plan. The purpose of OPA 24 is to guide the development and re-development of lands within the secondary plan area. The appeals against OPA 24 are site specific.
